Parry suggested having a GWWCA coffee cup made to give to invited guests and speakers of our membership meetings. Another idea would be to give it to members upon payment of their dues.

The board discussed the county Land Use Committee and GWWCA's representation on it. We currently are not receiving regular reports from our

Land Use rep. Monica will find out when the Land Use meetings are, and if they conflict with our membership meetings. The board agreed that we need to resolve this issue.
